RE: Mason-Morrow-Milgrove Road Closure postponed until Wednesday, May 5<sup>th</sup> due to weather - 3 day road closure for a road culvert replacement

Lebanon, Ohio – Salem Township, Warren County, Ohio – Mason-Morrow-Milgrove Road, located between Halls Creek Road and State Route 123, will be closed to traffic beginning Wednesday, May 5, 2021 for three (3) days, weather permitting. The road closure is for the replacement of a culvert pipe, which is being constructed by the Warren County Engineer's Office Highway Department. The road closure, which was originally planned to begin today on Monday, May 3, 2021, has been postponed until Wednesday, May 5, 2021 due to the weather.

The detour will utilize State Route 123 to US 22/SR 3 to Stubbs Mill Road.

## **About the Warren County Engineer**

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
