Daytime Closures on Wilmington Road for 3 Days for Resurfacing

Lebanon, Ohio – Washington Township, Warren County, Ohio – Wilmington Road, between Corwin Road and Lisle Lane, will be subject to daytime road closures between 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM for a total of 3 days beginning Thursday, June 10, 2021, weather permitting. This closure is necessary to complete resurfacing that is scheduled on Wilmington Road.

No detour will be posted, as traffic control will be handled by flaggers on each end of the closure. Emergency Vehicles will have access to the closure area should an emergency occur.

This work will be completed by Barrett Paving Materials, Inc. and the project is funded by the Warren County Engineer's Office.

They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
