Springboro Road to Close for Nine (9) Weeks for Bridge Rehabilitation

Lebanon, Ohio – Clearcreek Township, Warren County, Ohio – Springboro Road Bridge #41-2.49, over Bull Run between Pekin Road and Red Lion-Five Points Road, will be closed for rehabilitation beginning Monday, July 26, 2021, for nine (9) weeks, weather permitting.

The bridge rehabilitation will be constructed by Brumbaugh Construction, Inc. and the project is funded by the Warren County Engineer's Office.

The detour for the closure will utilize Red Lion-Five Points Road, Lower Springboro Road, Bunnell Hill Road and Pekin Road.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
