RE: Red Lion-Five Points Road Now Open

Lebanon, Ohio – Clearcreek Township, Warren County, Ohio – Red Lion-Five Points Road (CR126), at the intersection of Bunnell Hill Road (TR128), is now open. The closure was for the removal and realignment of Red Lion-Five Points Road to tie into Bunnell Hill Road.

Lytle-Five Points Road (CR46) and Bunnell Hill Road intersection is still closed. As a reminder, the detour for the Lytle-Five Points Road closure will utilize SR48 to SR73 to SR741 and the detour for the Bunnell Hill Road closure will utilize SR73 to SR48 to Social Row Road (Montgomery County).

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
