Lower Springboro Road to be closed between Township Line Road and Cincinnati-Columbus Road for 6 weeks.

Lebanon, Ohio – Wayne Township, Warren County, Ohio – Lower Springboro Road, between Township Line Road & Cincinnati-Columbus Road, will be closed beginning Monday, October 18th, 2021, for six (6) weeks, weather permitting. The closure is for the construction of a drilled pier wall to stabilize the roadway which will be completed by W.E. Smith Construction, Inc. This project is funded by the Warren County Engineer's Office.

The detour for the closure will utilize Township Line Road, Pekin Road, and Cincinnati-Columbus Road.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
