Cozaddale Road and Eltzroth Road to be closed for 1 week.

Lebanon, Ohio – Harlan Township, Warren County, Ohio – Cozaddale Road, at the Rail Road tracks, and Eltzroth Road, at the Rail Road tracks, will be closed beginning Tuesday, November 9th, 2021, for one (1) weeks, weather permitting. The closure is for the re-construction of the rail road tracks. This project is being constructed by the Safety Services and Supplies and funded by the rail road company.

The detour for the closure will utilize Roachester-Cozaddale Road, Long Spurling Road, SR132 and SR28.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
