King Avenue to Close for 3 days during Daytime Hours.

Lebanon, Ohio – Deerfield Township, Warren County, Ohio – King Avenue, at Miami Street, will be closed beginning Tuesday, March 1st, 2022, for three (3) days during the daytime hours of 9:00am to 2:00pm, weather permitting. The closure is for the Warren County Water Department to tie into the existing watermain. This project is being constructed by Barrett Paving Materials. Miami Street is currently closed and will remain closed after the watermain work is complete.

The detour for the closure will utilize Grandin Road, SR48, Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road and Columbia Road.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
