### **Columbia Road Northbound to Close for 8 Weeks.**

Lebanon, Ohio – Deerfield Township, Warren County, Ohio – Columbia Road northbound, between Kingsley Court and US22/SR3, will be closed beginning Monday, August 22, 2022, for eight (8) weeks, weather permitting. The closure is for the addition of a northbound right turn lane on Columbia Road at US22/SR3 and will be constructed by Rack and Ballauer Excavating Co. Inc. Southbound traffic will remain open for the duration of the project.

The detour for the northbound closure will utilize Fields-Ertel Road and US22/SR3.

They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.*
