### Middleboro Road Closure to be Extended.

Lebanon, Ohio – Harlan Township, Warren County, Ohio – Middleboro Road, between Henry-Plummert Road and the Clinton County Line, closure will be extended until Friday, October 21, 2022, weather permitting. The closure is for the Middleboro Road Bridge #45-0.16 Replacement Project and will be completed by the W.E. Smith Construction. The extended closure is due to incimate weather during the project.

The detour for the closure will utilize SR132, SR123, SR28, W. Main Street, N. Broadway Street and Middleboro Road.

They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.*
