Grandin Road to Open by Friday, November 4th

Lebanon, Ohio – Hamilton Township and City of South Lebanon, Warren County, Ohio – Grandin Road, between the Peter's Cartridge Factory Apartments/Cartridge Brewing entrance and Striker Road, will remain closed to through traffic for the King Avenue Bridge Replacement Project until Friday, November 4th, 2022, weather permitting. Access to the Peter's Cartridge Factory Apartments and to Cartridge Brewing will continue to be maintained from King Avenue in Deerfield Township for the duration of this closure.

The detour for the closure will continue to utilize King Avenue, Columbia Road, Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road, and SR 48.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
