### Fosters-Maineville Road to Close for 5 Days.

Maineville, Ohio – Hamilton Township, Warren County, Ohio – Fosters-Maineville Road, between Faller Road and Kings Court, will be closed beginning Monday, February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023, for five (5) days, weather permitting. The closure is for an underground utility construction, which will be completed by a contractor for the Warren County Water and Sewer Department.

The detour for the closure will utilize Old 3<sup>'</sup>C Highway, US22/SR3 and SR48.

They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.*
