Fosters-Maineville Road Closed Indefinitely.

Maineville, Ohio – Hamilton Township, Warren County, Ohio – Fosters-Maineville Road, between Faller Road and Kings Court, will remain closed until further notice. The closure is for the construction on an underground utility but a gas main was damaged. Repairs to the gas main are ongoing. The underground utility construction will continue after the gas main repairs are complete. After the underground utility construction is complete, extensive pavement repairs will be completed. We will send out an update(s) when appropriate. Construction for the underground utility is being completed by a contractor for the Warren County Water and Sewer Department.

The detour for the closure will utilize Old 3'C Highway, US22/SR3 and SR48.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
