### **Corwin Road Closure extended until July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023**

Lebanon, Ohio – Wayne Township, Warren County, Ohio – Corwin Road, between O'Neall Road and Smith Road, will be closed to traffic for an additional ten (10) days until July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The closure extension is necessary to complete construction of a new forced main line being installed by a contractor for Warren County Water and Sewer Department.

The detour for the closure will utilize Middletown Road, Waynesville Road, US 42, and Corwin Avenue.

They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.*
