Columbia Road and Davis Road Delays due to Utility Relocation

Lebanon, Ohio – Deerfield Township, Warren County, Ohio – Columbia Road and Davis Road, at the intersection of Columbia Road, Davis Road, and Myrtle Avenue, will experience traffic delays due to utility relocation on November 28th and 29th, 2023. The same intersection will experience traffic delays due to utility relocation on December 4th through December 7th, 2023 along Columbia Road as well as December 11th through December 22nd, 2023 along Davis Road. Traffic will be maintained by flaggers. The lane closure(s) are for utility relocation in preparation for the upcoming Columbia Road, Davis Road, and Myrtle Avenue Roundabout Project. The utility relocations will be completed by Duke Energy. Motorists may want to seek alternate routes to avoid delay.

There will be no detour posted.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
