King Avenue & Grandin Road to experience daytime lane closures.

Deerfield and Hamilton Townships, Warren County, Ohio – King Avenue and Grandin Road, located at the bridge crossing over the Little Miami River, will experience daytime lane closures starting Wednesday April 10th, 2024 through Wednesday April 24th, 2024, during the hours of 8:00am to 5:00pm. Single lane traffic will be maintained at this location with the use of temporary traffic signals. Lane closures are necessary for construction crews to complete concrete barrier wall sealing. Motorists may want to seek alternate routes to avoid delay.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
