Fields-Ertel Road and Snider Road Delays due to Tree Clearing

Lebanon, Ohio – Deerfield Township, Warren County and Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio.

- Fields-Ertel Road, mainly between Snider Road and Wilkens Blvd., and
- Snider Road, just north and south of Fields-Ertel Road,

will experience traffic delays due to tree clearing operations from February 26th to March 31st, 2024, weather permitting. Traffic will be maintained by flaggers. The lane closure(s) are for tree clearing operations in preparation for the upcoming construction of the Fields-Ertel Road Widening Project. Motorist may want to seek alternate routes to avoid delay.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
