Olive Branch Road to Close

Lebanon, Ohio – Washington Township, Warren County, Ohio – Olive Branch Road, between Corwin Road and Murray Road, will be closed beginning Monday, May 13, 2024, for four (4) weeks, weather permitting. The closure is for the construction of a drilled pier wall to stabilize the roadway which will be complete by W.E. Smith Construction, Inc. This project is funded by the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC), and the Warren County Engineer's Office.

The detour for the closure will utilize Corwin Road, Oregonia Road, and Murray Road.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
