RE: **Cox-Smith Road Closure**

Cox-Smith Road to be closed for eleven (11) weeks for water main installation.

Lebanon, Ohio – Union Township, Warren County, Ohio – Cox-Smith Road, located between Mason-Morrow-Milgrove Road and SR 741, will be closed beginning today, Monday, August 19, 2019, through October 30, 2019, weather permitting. The closure, which will occur during the daytime hours only, is for the installation of a water main, which is being constructed by a contractor for Greater Cincinnati Water Works. The detour will be Mason-Morrow-Milgrove Road to US 42 to SR 741. Residents that live on Cox-Smith Road will have access to and from their driveways. School buses will also have access.

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
