RE: Union Road to be closed for three (3) days for pavement repair work near Woodwind Ct.

Lebanon, Ohio – Turtlecreek Township, Warren County, Ohio – Union Road will be closed to traffic for three (3) days between Greentree Road and Hendrickson Road beginning Thursday, December 3, 2020, through Saturday, December 5, 2020, weather permitting. The closure, which is located at the southern edge of the Woodwind Ct intersection, is for pavement repair work being completed by the Warren County Water and Sewer Department as a result of a previous water main break.

Woodwind Ct will remain open to traffic; however, access to/from the neighborhood will only be to/from the north on Union Road, as access to/from the south on Union Road will be prohibited due to the closure.

The detour will utilize Greentree Road to Shaker Road to Hendrickson Road.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and

construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
