RE: **Morrow-Woodville Road, Harlan Township, closed to traffic for work on Railroad Crossing**

Lebanon, Ohio. Harlan Township, Warren County, Ohio – On Wednesday, December 9, 2020, Morrow-Woodville Rd. will be closed to traffic between State Route 132 and State Route 28 to allow railroad crossing repair by the I&O Railroad. This is a daytime closure only, between the hours of 9am-4pm, weather permitting. If work is not done that day, it will occur on Thursday, December 10th.

The detour will utilize State Route 132 to Morrow-Rossburg Road to State Route 28. Please adjust travel routes accordingly.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
