Western Row Road to Close During the Daytime Hours of 9:00am to 3:00pm for One Week for an Advance Warning System Installation

Lebanon, Ohio – Deerfield Township, Warren County, Ohio – Western Row Road (TR54), between Socialville-Fosters Road and Overton Way, will be closed during the daytime hours of 9:00am to 3:00pm for the installation of an Advance Warning System beginning Monday, October 25, 2021, for one (1) week, weather permitting.

The installation will be completed by Bansal Construction. The project is funded by the Deerfield Township Trustees and being managed by the Warren County TID.

The detour for the closure will utilize Socialville-Fosters Road and Columbia Road.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
