### Roachester-Cozaddale Road to Close for Two Days during Daytime Hours.

The closure is for Little Miami Gig to install an underground fiber line.

The detour for the closure will utilize Morrow-Rossburg Road, SR132, and Morrow-Woodville Road.

They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.*
