Lebanon, Ohio – Washington Township, Warren County, Ohio – Wilmington Road, between Lincoln Road and Ward-Koebel Road, will be closed beginning Monday, May 16, 2022, for three (3) days, weather permitting. The closure is for two culvert replacements and will be completed by the Warren County Highway Department.

The detour for the closure will utilize Middleboro Road, SR350, US22/SR3, and George Road.
