Grandin Road Closure Extended for 1 Week

Lebanon, Ohio – Hamilton Township and City of South Lebanon, Warren County, Ohio – Grandin Road, between the Peter's Cartridge Factory entrance and Striker Road, will remain closed to through traffic until Friday, May 27th, 2022, weather permitting. The extension of the closure is to allow Duke Energy Gas additional time to safely relocate their transmission main ahead of the King Avenue Bridge Replacement Project Improvements. It is anticipated that daytime lane closures, between the hours of 9:00am to 3:00pm, will follow the closure for approximately 2 weeks, in order to complete all gas relocation work along Grandin Road. Access to the Peter's Cartridge Factory and to Cartridge Brewing will be maintained at all times from King Avenue.

The detour for the closure will utilize King Avenue, Columbia Road, Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road, and SR 48.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
