Lytle-Five Points Road – Emergency Road Closure

Lebanon, Ohio – Clearcreek Township, Warren County, Ohio – Effective immediately, Lytle-Five Points Road, between Evan Court and Sycamore Trails Drive/Glenridge Blvd, will be closed to through traffic. The closure area is in front of Five Points Elementary School between their two driveways. The closure is due to very rough pavement caused by a utility company that damaged a watermain. The extent of the closure is still being determined.

The detour for the closure will utilize Bunnell Hill Road, SR73, and SR48.

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
