RE: Crossley Road to be closed for six weeks for a bridge replacement project.

Lebanon, Ohio – Clearcreek Township, Warren County, Ohio – Crossley Road, located between Red Lion-Five Points Road and Lytle-Five Points Road, will be closed beginning Monday, September 12, 2022, for six (6) weeks, weather permitting. The closure is for the replacement of bridge #127-0.51, which is being constructed by the Warren County Engineer's Office Highway Department.

The detour will utilize Lytle-Five Points Road, Bunnell Hill Road and Red Lion-Five Points Road.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
