Grandin Road to experience intermittent closures.

Hamilton Township, Warren County, Ohio – Grandin Road, between Grandin Ridge Drive and Venture Way, will experience intermittent closures Monday February 20th, 2023 through Thursday February 23rd, 2023, during the day time hours of 9:00am to 3:00pm. Closures are necessary for Duke Energy crews to complete short-term full closure(s) of Grandin Road to remove overhead lines at any time between 9:00am and 3:00pm. Specific time of the closure(s) are undetermined, and as these will be short-term closures, traffic will be stopped and held by law enforcement officers. Motorists may want to seek alternate routes to avoid delay. Intermittent single-lane restrictions will also be in place while crews are at work at other times, and traffic will be maintained by flaggers.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
