Hendrickson Road to Close for 12 Weeks for Bridge Rehabilitation

Lebanon, Ohio – Turtlecreek Township, Warren County, Ohio – Hendrickson Road Bridge #80-0.19 over Dicks Creek, between Audubon Drive and Bendel Drive, will be closed for a bridge rehabilitation beginning Monday, June 12, 2023, for twelve (12) weeks, weather permitting.

The bridge rehabilitation will be constructed by Brumbaugh Construction and the project is federally funded with funds from the Bridge Formula Program through the County Engineer's Association of Ohio.

The detour for the closure will utilize Cincinnati-Dayton Road, Roosevelt Avenue, Roosevelt Parkway, and Towne Boulevard.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
