### Corwin Road to Close for 2 Weeks

Lebanon, Ohio – Wayne Township, Warren County, Ohio – Corwin Road, between O'Neall Road and Smith Road, will be closed to traffic beginning Wednesday, July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023, for two (2) weeks. The closure is necessary for a new forced main line to be installed by a contractor for Warren County Water and Sewer Department.

The detour for the closure will utilize Middletown Road, Waynesville Road, US 42, and Corwin Avenue.

They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.*
