Morrow-Rossburg Road and Jackson-Runyan Road Closures at the At-Grade Railroad Crossings

Lebanon, Ohio – Harlan Township, Warren County, Ohio – Morrow-Rossburg Road, at the at-grade railroad crossing, and Jackson-Runyan Road, at the at-grade railroad crossing, will be closed beginning Thursday, October 5th, 2023, for two (2) days, weather permitting. The closure is for repair work of the at-grade railroad crossing. This project is being performed by a Contractor for Indiana and Ohio Railway.

The detour for Morrow-Rossburg Road will utilize SR132, Pleasant-Plain Road and SR28.

The detour for Jackson-Runyan Road will utilize Morrow-Woodville Road, SR132, Pleasant-Plain Road and SR28.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
