Davis Road Daytime Closure due to Utility Relocation

Lebanon, Ohio – Deerfield Township, Warren County, Ohio – Davis Road, between Columbia Road and Willow Creek Drive, will be closed to traffic, on December 11th through December 22nd, 2023, during the daytime hours of 8:00am to 4:00pm. The daytime closures are due to the utility relocation in preparation for the upcoming Columbia Road, Davis Road, and Myrtle Avenue Roundabout Project. The utility relocations will be completed by a contractor for Duke Energy.

The detour will utilize Rich Road, Fields-Ertel Road and Columbia Road.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.). They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
