Liberty-Keuter Road to Close

Lebanon, Ohio – Turtlecreek Township, Warren County, Ohio – Liberty-Keuter Road, between Oregonia Road and Hatfield Road, will be closed beginning Monday, April 29, 2024, for four (4) weeks, weather permitting. The closure is for the construction of a drilled pier wall to stabilize the roadway which will be complete by W.E. Smith Construction, Inc. This project is funded by Turtlecreek Township and the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC).

The detour for the closure will utilize Oregonia Road, SR48, US42, Utica Road and Hatfield Road.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
